




Our platinum Open Access journals are available to read in digital format without subscription, and there are no fees to submit or publish an article.







UWP offers Green and Gold Open Access models in our hybrid journals.










Green:

- Authors can self-archive the AAM of their article in a university/noncommercial subject repository, or personal website/departmental website.
- Unless mandated otherwise, it can be available to download 18 months after the publication date of the final version in UWP's journal.
- The abstract should contain a full citation of the published article (to include author name, name and issue of journal, year, ISSN, DOI link, and state UWP as publisher).
- It is the responsibility of the author to ensure any necessary permissions for third party copyright material have been cleared for OA.

• UWP recommends using the CC BY NC ND licence. However, if a funder mandate requires a different CC BY licence, please contact UWP's Commissioning Department to discuss.

Gold:

- By paying an APC, we can publish your article on a Gold OA basis, i.e. it is made OA immediately on publication of UWP's journal. If you require Gold OA, please contact UWP's Commissioning Department when your article is accepted for publication.
- The APC is payable before the journal as a whole is formally handed over to the editorial and production processes.
- The version of record can be uploaded to non-commercial repositories of the author's choice. It will also be OA on Ingenta, the journal hosting platform used by UWP.
- It is the responsibility of the author to ensure any necessary permissions for third party copyright material have been cleared for OA.
- UWP recommends using the CC BY NC ND licence. However, if a funder mandate requires a different CC BY licence, please contact UWP's Commissioning Department to discuss.

We comply fully with the open access requirements of UKRI, Wellcome, and Plan S. Where required by their funder, authors retain the right to distribute their author accepted manuscript (AAM) via an institutional and/or subject repository (e.g. Europe PMC) under a Creative Commons license, for release on the date of first online publication.

Which Creative Commons license do we recommend?

UWP uses a regime of licenses created by Creative Commons. These licenses tell readers what they can/cannot do with OA content.

We recommend <u>CC BY NC ND</u>.

CC BY NC ND means the following:

- CC: anyone may share or download your work
- BY: you must always be credited as the author
- NC: OA version must not be used or sold commercially
- ND: No one is allowed to change your work

However, if a funder mandate/other requirement specifies a different CC BY licence, please contact your Commissioning Editor for advice.

Can my OA article include third-party material?

We'd advise that imagery used in the article is available under a CC BY license.

If you intend to use copyrighted imagery which isn't available under a CC BY license, any such imagery must be accompanied by a caption which clearly states: the details of the copyright holder, and that the imagery cannot be reused under the CC BY licence applied to the article. It is the author/editors' responsibility to seek permission to include third party materials if in copyright.
